ABOUT YOUTH OUTREACH SERVICES

Youth Outreach Service (YOS) is a non-profit organization focused on helping at-risk youth in the Chicago area to reach their potential. For over 60 years, our focus has been on caring for teens that face challenges at home, in school and in the community.

YOS provides critical services in some of the highest need communities in Chicago and its western suburbs. For many clients, the severity of their struggles runs deep, including homelessness, substance addiction, mental health issues, family conflict, gang involvement, and delinquency. Our goal is to inspire positive development so clients and their families can face challenges with confidence with the ongoing support they need to thrive for a lifetime.

YOS responds to the needs of youth where they are at, both emotionally as well as physically, whether that be within programs in schools, at clients' homes and at our offices. We provide comprehensive services from our four service areas depending on each client's needs: Counseling, Prevention, Child Welfare and Juvenile Justice.

HISTORY

In 1959, Rev. Stan Davis of Galewood United Church of Christ established an outreach program for neighborhood youth of Chicago's Northwest side. Over the next 60 years, the organization expanded the area it serves and eventually changed its name to Youth Outreach Services in 1984. Youth services expanded into the western suburbs in the 1960's in Proviso and Leyden Townships. In 1971, we became one of Illinois' first adolescent substance abuse providers. YOS added a crisis intervention team to serve runaway and homeless youth, in 1977. By the 1980's, we added Prevention services to reach youth before they went too far down a negative path. In doing so, we saw a great need to work with youth involved in the juvenile justice system, so began offering community-based detention alternatives in 1995. We also added a foster care program for those youth abused or neglected, involved in the child welfare system. By the 2000's, YOS made strategic decisions to expand to more communities, and offering proven and effective interventions that put us on the map as one of the top social service agencies in Cook County and Illinois. Today, as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, we have a staff of 120 professionals, working in 23 Chicago communities and 43 suburban Cook neighborhoods, offering 20+ programs or services.









WHY CORPORATE GIVING

Every year, Youth Outreach Services partners with companies, big and small, to connect generous people to worthy causes and families in need. Fundraising Matches

Fundraising matches, such as matching gifts, provide YOS with your company's donations after YOS has reached a fundraising benchmark or goal. This is usually associated with a fundraising event or campaign. The participant employer will match the money we raise through sponsorships or other donations. YOS will recognize and promote your company's branding during events so that you get maximum exposure to our network of supporters.



Community Grants

Community grants from your company is a pre-established, agreed-upon set amount focused on one of YOS's specific youth programs, agency efforts or capital projects. This option offers your company a focused endeavor to see a direct positive impact in the community, with clear objectives, timelines, and goals. YOS is happy to align such a grant with your mission and values.



In-Kind Product Donations

Products or services that your company specializes in are great ways to give back to YOS. For instance, companies may donate computers, consulting services, food, or marketing strategies. This option allows YOS to benefit from valued and needed products and services, and your company can feel pride in knowing you've helped a worthy cause. Volunteer Events

Volunteer events are great corporate giving programs that allow your company to give your time, in -person or virtually, to those in need. This is a great team building activity that can benefit all parties involved. YOS receives both volunteered time and money, while your employees feel accomplished by volunteering for a great cause, and the company, as a whole, gets to demonstrate their philanthropy and interest in bettering the community.



Annual Giving

Companies are encouraged to donate at certain times of the year. The most common time for companies to give is at the end of the year. This can be either a corporate donation and/or a compilation of employee gifts. YOS commonly has high-peak donation times throughout the year, such as around the holidays as well as during fall's back-to-school time.

Youth Activity Sponsorship

As a part of our youth programming across 20+ service offerings, YOS incorporates field trips and outings for the youth to gain experience, explore the world, and have fun. This may include trips to museums, the zoo, picnics or restaurants, recreational centers, movie nights, camping trips, and more. Your company can help by planning one of these fun gatherings, or sponsor a one-time or recurring event.

Community Events

Community fundraisers are events organized and hosted by you! There are a wide variety of ways to fundraise – you can host an event, or set up an online fundraising page. Such events may include a car wash, bake sale, sports tournament, 5K walk, or motorcycle ride event. You, as the event organizers, are fully responsible for organizing and hosting your fundraising event. YOS can provide guidance, answer questions, have staff members attend, and provide YOS materials. Giving to YOS's unrestricted fund allows money to rapidly flow to the areas that need it most.





CASE STUDY 1

The First Congregational Church of La Grange selected the "Adopt a Room" project. Church parishioners and the confirmation class of youth fundraised, purchased furniture needs, and spent a weekend decorating the office space in Melrose Park, Illinois. The kids and church fundraised over \$3,000, allowing for two of our therapy rooms to be revamped into beautiful, welcoming spaces.

CASE STUDY 2

All supplies and food were donated by the companies, in addition to hours of their time.

CASE STUDY 4
